The key words "MUST", "MUST NOT", "REQUIRED", "SHALL", "SHALL NOT", "SHOULD", "SHOULD NOT", "RECOMMENDED", "MAY", and "OPTIONAL" in this document are to be interpreted as described in RFC 2119. (see RFC2119)

With the release of version 0.190.0 of Aquilo, the following changes become effective. These have also been included in the published documentation. Contradictory wording in the documentation or newer versions of this document will invalidate this document.

Amendment

The new version of Aquilo introduces the renounced result state. A result can have exactly one of the following six (6) states. Each state MUST only be entered under the following conditions.

- Normal Result (e.g. 7.0), MUST be used if the competitor finishes the round under compliance of all applicable Rules according to the LPO, WBO and AIEC Technical Regulations.
- Renounced (ren), SHOULD be used if the competitor has no prospect of progressing to the next round due to his result in the current ride and renounces the completion of the round for the good of the horse.
- Eliminated (elim), MUST be used if the competitor does not complete the round.
- Retired (reti), MUST be used if the participant ends the round of their own volition.
- Disqualified (noRank), MUST be used if the participant is disqualified from the round or competition.
- No result (), technical condition, listed for completeness only

Technical

To ensure downward compatibility, the status codes for results change according to Table 1. The program automatically converts old results into the new format.
